

EFFECTIVE METHODS OF TEACHING ENGLISH TO YOUNG LEARNERS

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Abstract: This article highlights several ways to learn English effectively and some of the modern learning technologies in language learning as well.

- "Merry Riddles" teaching riddles to students is important in teaching English, they learn unfamiliar words and find the answer to riddles;
 - "Quick answers" helps to increase the efficiency of the lesson;
- "Chigil yazdi" ("Warm-up exercises") use various games in the classroom to interest students in the lesson [3];
- "Pantomime" (pantomime) is a method it can be used in a lesson where very difficult topics need to be explained or when written exercises are done and students are tired;
 - "A chain story" method helps students to develop oral speech;
- "Acting characters" method can be used in all types of lessons. In order to teach the profession, people in professions such as "Interpreter", "Translator", "Writer", "Poet" can participate in the class and talk with students;
- "Thinkers meeting" poets and writers such as U. Shakespeare, A. Navoi, R. Burns can be "invited". At such a time, using the wise words they said in the lesson will help young people to be educated as perfect people.

- -The "When pictures speak" method is very convenient and helps to teach English and develop the oral speech of students, for this, it is necessary to use pictures related to the topic;
- Quiz cards are distributed according to the number of students and allow all students to participate in the lesson at the same time, which saves time.

As we have seen, each innovative technology has its own advantages. In all such methods, cooperation between the teacher and the student, the active action of the student in the educational process is envisaged.

It is very similar to how we learn our mother tongue. The author gives an example of how young children learn how to speak - after all, no



one explains to them the rules for building sentences, cases and parts of speech. In the same way, Igor Yuryevich Shekhter suggests learning English.

- 2. Dragunkin's method Alexander Nikolaevich Dragunkin's distinctive feature of the system is the focus on the native Russian language in learning any foreign language. The author, who very boldly called the English language simple, emphasizes that its roots go back to the ancient Russian language, especially the system of grammatical tenses. Students of the Dragunkin course learn new words transcribed in Russian letters, and grammatical constructions are divided not into the 12 tenses known to us from school, but into the past, present, future and their changes.
- 3. Petrov Method Dmitry Petrov says that you can learn English in 16 hours. True, the author once again clarifies that we are not talking about language acquisition at the level of a UK-born citizen, but about basic knowledge. His lessons are enough to survive in an English-speaking environment, explain your needs and understand the response.

In conclusion, it should be said that teaching a modern language is aimed at forming a more cultured person, who has the skills of self-analysis and systematization of new knowledge. Innovative methods are an integral part of the modernization of the entire system.
